### **Overview**

Alan Karbelnig, PhD, ABPP, training and supervising psychoanalyst at the New Center for Psychoanalysis in Los Angeles, explores the transition in the concepts of transference and countertransference in this two-day program. During the first day, he discusses the evolution in the concept of transference, following the chronology from earliest conceptualizations, to the transition occurring during the mid-20th century, to contemporary views. Dr. Karbelnig follows a similar format in studying the idea of countertransference the following day. He concludes each day with multiple clinical examples, including erotic and aggressive transference and countertransference manifestations, demonstrating how to manage them clinically. Dr. Karbelnig will allow plenty of time for questions and comments.
