#### **I. 2008/09 CME Programme of Macau Chinese Medical Association (CMA)**

The Macau CMA has asked the College to assist in providing speakers for their CME activities in Macau. These activities would take place on a Sunday of each month in 2009 for a one-year period. There will be a total of four sessions in the one-year period and each session will consist of two lectures lasting for one hour each.

The Education Committee, in collaboration with the Scientific Committee, has devised the following programme and criteria for selection of speakers:

1. Criteria for application as speaker:
  - a. Post-fellowship for five years
  - b. Preferable attributes:
    - i. had been or is serving as a psychiatric trainer, or
    - ii. experienced in delivering open lectures to mental health professionals and/or doctors,
    - iii. able to prepare teaching materials in Chinese/English bilingually
  - c. Fluent in Cantonese
2. Lecture topics:
  - a. Depressive disorders in primary care
  - b. Detecting psychotic disorders in the community
  - c. Management of common sleep problems
  - d. Anxiety and panic disorders
  - e. Perinatal psychiatric problems
  - f. Impulse control problems – e.g. pathological gambling
  - g. Management of acute stress and adjustment disorders
  - h. How to handle psychosomatic disorders

An honorarium of Macau Patacas (MOP)16,000 is offered for each session of teaching.
