Speaker : Professor David Taylor BSc, MSc, PhD, MICR, FCMHP, FFRPS, FRPharmS

David Taylor is Director of Pharmacy and Pathology at the Maudsley Hospital, Professor of Psychopharmacology at King's College, London and Honorary Professor at the Institute of Psychiatry, Psychology and Neuroscience.

David is also the Editor-in-Chief of the journal Therapeutic Advances in Psychopharmacology and Head of Pharmaceutical Sciences in King's Health Partners. He has previously been President of the College of Mental Health Pharmacists and Chairman of the UK Psychiatric Pharmacy Group.

In 2014, David was ranked in the top 100 clinical leaders in the NHS by the Health Service Journal.

Professor Taylor has been the lead author of the Maudsley Prescribing Guidelines since their inception in 1993. The Maudsley Prescribing Guidelines has sold over 250,000 copies in twelve editions and been translated into eleven languages.

David has also authored around 235 clinical papers in journals such as the BMJ, British Journal of Psychiatry and Journal of Clinical Psychiatry. These papers have been cited over 6500 times. Professor Taylor has an H Index of 49.

Professor Taylor has written or edited six books and written over twenty book chapters.
