Obituary

Dr NG Hon-shing

Dr NG Hon-shing, aged 68, passed away peacefully on July 14, 2016. Dr Ng was a distinguished psychiatrist with a long list of contributions in the field for over 40 years.

Dr Ng obtained his MBBS from the University of Hong Kong in 1972. He joined the Mental Health Services in 1973 and had worked in Castle Peak Hospital and Siu Lam Psychiatric Centre in his early years of training. He was also trained at the Institute of Mental Health, King's College, London from 1978 to 1979, and became a member of the Royal College of Psychiatrists in 1980.

Dr Ng was the pioneer in rehabilitation psychiatry. As the first consultant leading the then newly established Rehabilitation Psychiatric Team in Kwai Chung Hospital in 1988, Dr Ng set the scene for training in this subspecialty in Hong Kong. From 1993 to 2001, Dr Ng was appointed as the Hospital Chief Executive of Castle Peak Hospital and was instrumental in overseeing the redevelopment project of the hospital during his service there. He was subsequently appointed as consultant psychiatrist in Kowloon Hospital in 2003 and held the position until his retirement in 2007. His rich experience in hospital administration helped the development and implementation of the new gazette psychiatric wards in Kowloon Hospital. Dr Ng had been in private practice after his retirement. He was highly regarded as a responsible, diligent and sensible senior. His ability to maintain equanimity and perseverance in spite of challenges has demonstrated the invaluable quality of a distinguished psychiatrist who dedicated his heart in his career.

Dr Ng served actively in the New Life Psychiatric Rehabilitation Association for many years in promoting the recovery model and supporting patients in recovery. Dr Ng was the Chairperson of the Executive Committee of New Life Psychiatric Rehabilitation Association from 2006 to 2008. Dr Ng had served in different Committees of the College over the years. He had been appointed as an examiner of the College Fellowship examinations, a member of the Review Committee from 2008-2010, and a member of the Fellowship Selection Committee from 2010 - 2016.

He is survived by his wife Georgia, two sons Alan and Steven and a daughter Helene. His contributions in the promotion of mental health in the community will be always appreciated and remembered.
