

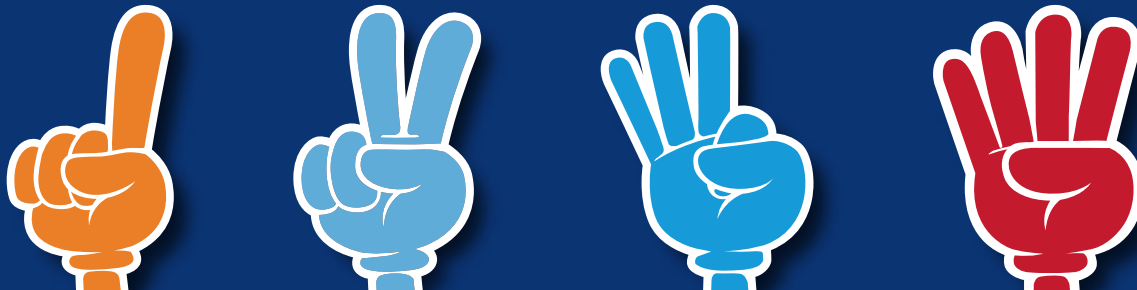

Dr Gopal is a graduate of Duke University and completed his residency training at the Baylor College of Medicine. He completed his MD degree at Rutgers University – Robert Wood Johnson Medical School in 1995. The main focus of his current duties at Janssen R&D includes the design, conduct and analysis of efficacy trials in the area of Schizophrenia (Phase 1-3). Dr Gopal is also responsible for the characterization of the emerging safety profile for the compounds under his development. He has interacted with numerous health authorities around the world regarding clinical trial issues including the Taiwan, US, Japan, Brazil, Mexico, Sweden, China, EU and Canada. A prolific scientific writer, he has authored more than 120 peer reviewed publications, book chapters and posters. Some of his work has been published in high profile journals such as Journal of Clinical Psychiatry, JAMA and Nature.



David Taylor is Director of Pharmacy and Pathology at the Maudsley Hospital, Professor of Psychopharmacology at King's College, London and Honorary Professor at the Institute of Psychiatry, Psychology and Neuroscience. Professor Taylor David has been the lead author of the Maudsley Prescribing Guidelines since their inception in 1993. He is also the Editor-in-Chief of the journal Therapeutic Advances in Psychopharmacology and Head of Pharmaceutical Sciences in King's Health Partners. He has previously been President of the College of Mental Health Pharmacists and Chairman of the UK Psychiatric Pharmacy Group.
