I. College Research Grant 2013/14

The College has set up a mini-research grant to support young fellows, who attained the College fellowship for not more than five years, to conduct locally oriented research projects in agreed aspects. A working group has been set up to vet applications. The amount of grant normally does not exceed HK\$100,000, with an expected duration of project of not more than two years.
