Speaker: Prof Paul Mullen

Paul Mullen is Professor Emeritus of Forensic Psychiatry at Monash University, Australia. He is an eminent forensic psychiatrist and internationally renowned as a clinician and researcher, in both psychiatry and neurology. He is regularly invited to speak about his research around the world. He was the Foundation Clinical Director at the Victorian Institute of Forensic Mental Health in Australia. Professor Mullen also has an extensive clinical and research background. His research interests include the relationship between mental disorder and criminal behavior, stalking, the long-term impact of childhood sexual abuse, jealousy, and litigious and chronic complainers. He has also contributed to debate on false memory syndrome, within the context of the phenomenon of child sexual abuse. He has some 180 publications in journals, has contributed over 40 chapters in books, including chapters in both of the standard British textbooks on forensic psychiatry, and is the author of four books.
