I. The President's Prize for Best Part III Candidates sponsored by the Yao Yiu Sai Education and Charitable Memorial Fund

The results of the captioned prize for 2009 are as follows:

Best Part III candidate award: **Dr. CHUNG Kar-kin Albert** and **Dr. POON Yuan-ling Yvette Larissa**

Each winner will be given approximately HK\$20,000 for the purpose of financing a period of overseas training in psychiatry of his/her choice or to attend the Annual Meeting of the Royal College of Psychiatrists of that year.

III. Best Original Research by Trainees 2009 (Hong Kong Academy of Medicine)

Dr. Leung's work on "*Facial Emotion Recognition in Chinese with Schizophrenia at Early and Chronic Stages of Illness*" was selected as one of the six finalists in the final presentation for the prize on 18 December 2009. We are happy to report that Dr. Leung was awarded the *silver medal* in the contest.

IV. Announcement from The Board of Examiners

Clinical Assessment of Skills and Competencies (CASC) of the Royal College of Psychiatrists will be held in Hong Kong for the first time on 18-20 May 2010. This examination will be run subject to a minimum of 16 candidates, or else applicants will be allocated to the centre in the United Kingdom in the examination in March 2010 (subject to meeting the CASC eligibility requirements). Priority will be given to Hong Kong trainees, followed by those who are based in the South Asia / Asia Pacific region.

V. The Second HK-UK Joint International Conference

The College in collaboration with the Royal College of Psychiatrists will be organising the Second HK-UK Joint International Conference on 11 – 13 December 2010, details of which can be found in the enclosed pamphlet.

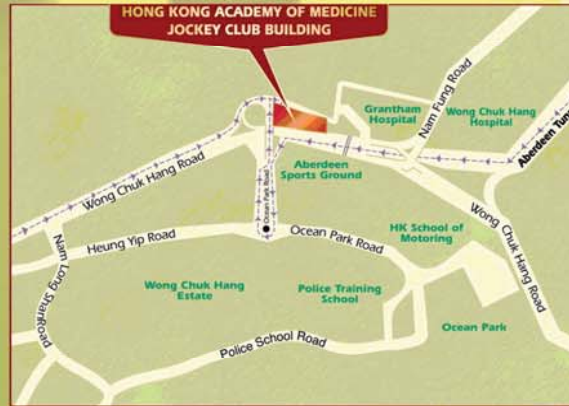
