Dr Nigel Strauss

Dr Nigel Strauss has been a consultant and occupational psychiatrist for over 30 years. He is the medical director of the Millswyn Clinic, a specialist psychiatric outpatient facility in Melbourne and director of Occupational Psychiatry, an organization that takes psychiatry into the workplace. Dr Strauss has been one of the pioneers of psychiatric impairment assessments in Australia and has coauthored several impairment measurement guides which are currently in use under government legislation in Australia. He is one of the two recognized impairment trainers working in Victoria under the auspices of the Australian Medical Association. His current publication, the Occupational Psychiatry Impairment Guide is currently under consideration by Comcare, the federal workers compensation insurer for useage Australia wide.

Dr Chung See-yuen

Dr CHUNG is one of the most experienced psychiatric specialists in Hong Kong. He is the Foundation Fellow of the Hong Kong College of Hong Kong since 1993 and an elected Fellow of the Royal College of Psychiatrists since 1998. He had been worked in the Department of Psychiatry, University of Hong Kong as a Clinical Associate Professor and started his private practice in 1989. Dr CHUNG is full of experience in psychiatric reports writing particularly in both forensic and compensation aspects. He has often been invited to prepare forensic reports and to attend Court as expert witness.

Ms Clara Choi, Labour Officer of the Labour Department, is a standing member of the Employees' Compensation Assessment Board appointed by the Commissioner for Labour. She regularly sits in the Employees' Compensation Assessment Board in respect of various medical specialties. Conversant with the Labour Law and the employees' compensation system in Hong Kong, she will give us a snapshot of the Employees' Compensation Ordinance, which governs the compensation claim for work injuries in our territory.
